





"Our goal is to promote sustainable football clubs based on supporters' involvement & community ownership"



- We believe that football clubs are not just sporting institutions, but social and civic ones.
- They must therefore be protected from short-term speculation and bad ownership.



SD began in October 2000 in England, when a supporter of Northampton Town Football Club (League Two in England) set up the first supporters' trust to save his club.



- Supporters' Trusts, are democratic, not-for-profit associations open to all supporters.
- They aim to be involved in the ownership and running of their football clubs.
- This is done by owning shares and electing directors to the boards of those clubs



We have helped to establish supporters' trusts at over 65% of the top 92 football clubs in England.

SD helps to represent the views of supporters' trusts to the football authorities; government and to other interested groups and organisations







In 2007, we published a report showing that supporters all over Europe had similar problems, and would benefit from our help.

In Spain we support the work of FASFE, who are also afiliated to SD.


We advise on campaigning, policy, support the development of their network, and attend events and conferences.
